Dermapen Micro-needling

How does it work?

Dermapen is known as microneedling and uses fine small needles to create microchannels, stimulating the body to produce collagen and elastin which imporves the appearance of the skin it is very effective for scars, stretch marks and pigmentation.

What can I expect from my treatment?

Dermapen treatments can cause minimal discomfort the treatment is around 30 minutes and uses products that can penetrate into the skin and boost the results of the treatment. 6-8 sessions usually recommended 4-6 weeks apart with usually some homecare recommended in between.

Visibly rejuvenated skin can generally be seen after just 6-8 days following a procedure, with results further improving over time. A course of Dermapen[™] sessions is usually recommended to achieve optimal results; however, improvement is usually noticeable after just one treatment.

What aftercare should I follow?

- Avoid IPL and laser which can cause scarring
- Botox should be avoided two weeks before and two weeks after
- No makeup, creams or touching for 12 hours
- Avoid swimming and exercise for 24 hours

Is Dermapen[™] safe?

Allergic reactions and side-effects are unlikely to occur. The procedure is minimally invasive, which means that there is virtually no downtime and the healing process is quick. Aftercare is also very simple and can be fully administered at home.

Are there any side effects or risks associated with skin needling?

Side effects experienced with Dermapen[™] will usually subside within 48 hours. They include erythema, stinging, itching and tightness of the skin.

What can be expected after Dermapen[™] treatment?

In the days after it is possible to experience slight swelling, red and a feeling of mild sunburn can occur. Sometimes flaky, dry and itchy skin is experienced. Occasionally pimples appear as toxins are released from the body but these resolve quickly.
